

Your Moving Checklist

A MONTH BEFORE THE MOVE

	If you're handling your own packing, you can purchase anything you might need at
П	our warehouse. You can also find free used supplies on social media sites. Start to thin out closets, the garage, and attic. Double check that older boxes are
_	still servicable, and repack them as needed.
H	Plan a garage sale or donate your unwanted things to charity. Update your address with your local post office or change it online.
	Notify insurance companies and your financial institutions.
TWO WEEKS BEFORE THE MOVE	
	If you decide to pack yourself, label all your boxes as you pack. Write the destination room on the top and sides of each moving box to ensure it gets to the right place in your new home. Feel free to visit our warehouse and shop for extra
	packing supplies, or for a small additional fee we can even deliver them to you! Schedule disconnects for utilities such as cable, gas, electric, and water, and schedule connections for your new residence.
THE WEEK OF THE MOVE	
	Finish packing and be sure all items are boxed and ready to go prior to the movers'
	arrival. Give us a call if you might need us to help with the rest of your packing! Think about where your kids and pets will be during the time of the move, and if
	necessary, plan for them to go to a relative or friend's house during that time. Ensure you have transportation to your new home for yourself, family, and pets.
DAY OF THE MOVE	
	Create a safe path for the movers to navigate by clearing your driveway of objects,
	snow, or ice. Pack your suitcase with any essential personal items, identification documents, cash, and jewelry.
	Be sure that you or a trusted representative are present when the movers arrive so
	you can walk us through the home and indicate what you need moved or anything in particular we should be aware of.
	Once all of your belongings are loaded onto the moving truck, be sure to do one final walkthrough with the crew to be sure nothing was missed. Lock all windows and outside doors, in addition to checking all lights and your thermostat are off before heading to your new home.
